



# Epsilon Tau Pi Foundation Scholarship 2022



## Requirements

All Applicants for Epsilon Tau Pi (ETPi) Foundation Scholarship Must:

1. Have been granted the Eagle Scout rank or have verified that their application for Eagle Scout rank has been received at the BSA National Office. Applicants may verify this by having their local council contact the Epsilon Tau Pi Foundation at [scholarship@epsilontaupi.org](mailto:scholarship@epsilontaupi.org) or photocopy their certificate.
2. Applications can be submitted electronically or by mail. Submissions of electronic copies must be received by **June 5, 2022** to be considered, and may be word document, .pdf, or image files. Mailed applications must be postmarked by **June 5, 2022**. Use sufficient postage.
3. Be an incoming first year student entering a University with an Epsilon Tau Pi Chapter or Colony, see <https://etp-foundation.org/> for an up-to-date listing of sites, in the year in which the ETPi Foundation Scholarship application is submitted.
4. Provide a transcript of high school grades covering at least six semesters (The transcript does not have to be "official").
5. If you have taken the SAT and/or the ACT. Scores must be submitted as a copy of an official test sheet, or on the high school transcript in Requirement 4, and must be submitted with the application.
6. Have and continually demonstrated leadership ability in Scouting and have a strong record of participation in activities outside of Scouting.
7. Provide a statement on which point of the scout law you feel is most important or sets a scout apart from non-scouts and how do you demonstrate that trait in your daily life. (min. 500 words, max. 2000).
8. Provide one signed recommendation letter from volunteer or professional Scout leader who knows the applicant personally. This is the only endorsement required. Please do not send endorsements from teachers, counselors, etc.
9. Be available to possibly participate in an interview with the scholarship committee. We will contact you to schedule the interview if it is deemed necessary by the committee.

## Procedures

All Applicants for ETPi Foundation Scholarship Must:

- Complete the application personally.
- Enclose only the items requested in the requirements (No biographies, resumes, or supplementary lists of activities). Items should not be attached to the application.
- Answer all questions on the application ("See attached" is not an acceptable answer).
- Submit all attachments with the application form to ensure that all items are available for review at the same time (Epsilon Tau Pi will not assume responsibility for matching items that are mailed separately).
- Include on each attachment the applicant's name.
- Be advised that only those applications received or postmarked by June 5<sup>th</sup> will be considered.
